Yes, I am a king. I was born for this, I came into the world for this: to bear witness to the truth; and all who are on the side of truth listen to my voice.

As God and as man Jesus has infinite power in his kingship, flowing through his truth and his love. We need to trust this! His truth and love already have infinite power. When we do trust this, we relax into our own goodness too. We are far more compelling when we simply share the Gospel message, rather than try to impose it in any way on adults. We also tend to love more naturally when it comes from a peaceful heart. Jesus himself reveals this comfort with his power: he is not flustered in the presence of Pilate, neither is he frantically trying to save himself. His interest is in seeking to help Pilate understand the truth, for his power is to save others not himself. (Online)
