LENT - ASH WEDNESDAY

This is a reminder that we must die. But also a reminder that we live only due to the will of God, and we will live again, only through the deliverance of Jesus Christ. God created us from dust and although our bodies will return to dust, our immortal souls will live again, thanks to Christ's sacrifice, hence the sign of the cross.

Ash Wednesday is a day of repentance, prayer and fasting. After receiving our ashes, pray and meditate on this simple truth: Our bodies come from dust, and to dust they shall return, but our souls will live forever thanks to the sacrifice of Jesus Christ on the cross.
