St Winefride's Chapel and Holy Well Pilgrimage



On the 17th of June, thirty nine pilgrims from the combined parishes of Our Lady of Lourdes, Old Hill, Our Lady of Lourdes, Kingswinford and St Marys, Brierley Hill journeyed to St Winefrede's Chapel in Holywell. St Winefride was the daughter of a local prince named Tewyth and his wife Gwenlo. Her uncle was St. Beuno. In the year 630 AD, Caradoc, a chieftain from Hawarden attempted to seduce Winefride. She re-

fused him, and sheltered in a church built by her uncle. Caradoc pursued her and cut off her head. In the place where her head fell, a spring of water came up. St. Beuno came out from the church, took up her head and placed it back on her body. He then prayed and raised her to life. A white scar encircled her neck, witness to her martyrdom. Winefride spent the rest of her life as a nun. The site is the oldest continually visited pilgrim site in Britain and over the past 1300 years, hundred of testimonies attest to the healing powers of the spring water.

We enjoyed Veneration of the Relic of St. Winefride's beside the sanctuary pool followed by a delicious lunch provided by the Bridgettine sisters at St Winefrede's guest house. We had the special opportunity to celebrate Mass led by Fr Shanju in the beautiful 15th century chapel on site. Finally, pilgrims were encouraged to enter the exterior pool, which was very cold!

We then journeyed on to the beautiful Pantasaph Monastery. The friary was founded in 1852 and was previously home to a Franciscan community. The site was taken over by the Vincentian Congregation last year who have continued to maintain the site as well has operating a retreat centre on site. We spent a peaceful afternoon enjoying the hospitality of the team, relaxing in the picturesque Padrio Pio garden and enjoy-

ing the beautiful stations of the cross on Calvary Hill. Everyone really enjoyed their prayerful day; it was good to spend time together and meet with friends from other parishes. We hope that Fr Shanju will organise more pilgrimages for us all.
