"It is the spirit that gives life. That is so central to understanding life: meaning, love, direction can only come from that which we cannot see. But the complementarity of God means that the physical is still important and beautiful when it is a true vehicle of the spirit. We wouldn't know anything, if it wasn't for the physical. We can't get baptised without water. We couldn't receive Christ in his fullness without bread and wine. And today, it is powerful that the Spirit is 'seen' for the first time as a dove. The Mass has been simplified since the 60s, but gesture and posture are still important. Think about the importance of kneeling, and it is good to be aware of our other positions too, and the few simple gestures we are invited to make - as well as the ones the priest makes. So, before the homily, go through the different gestures we make during Mass, and see how many you really understand!
