### <u>St Mary's 1873 - 2023</u>

As St Mary's celebrates its 150th anniversary you might be interested in a little bit of its history.

In 1854 Fr Walter Keen, then at the Catholic Mission in Stourbridge (that Church hadn't yet been built) bought a pub, grounds and a bowling green for £1400 - approximately £250,000 today. The pub had been called the Mouth of the Nile but was changed to the Golden Lion at some point, and this is where the Parish centre is now. The front of this building is original and is Grade 2 listed, dating back to the start of the 1800's. When the first Mass was said in the old pub 200 people attended and a tent was put up on the bowling green to hold them all. Church is a bit warmer and more comfortable today. This pub was used for all Masses and services until the Church could be built.

The Church was built on the bowling green and was opened on the 15th October 1873 by Bishop Ullathorne. No records have been found as the cost of building the Church but it would have been around £500,000 to £1,000,000 in today's money. All of it raised by the Catholics of the area and the debt continued to be paid off for many, many years.

EW Pugin was the Architect, son of Augustus Pugin who designed the Houses of Parliament and this son also designed Our Lady and All Saints in Stourbridge which opened in 1864.

Carved into the Pulpit are the symbols of the four Gospel writers who also appear on the Reredos at the back of the Altar. The four Patron Saints were added in 1899 along with new gas lamps and very basic heating.

There is no graveyard as surrounding the pub and bowling green were many cottages and a school and even a brick kiln so we never had the land to have our own cemetery. In 1873 it was illegal for Catholic Churches to have peel of bells, and indeed it still is, so we have an unfinished bell tower.
