TRINITY SUNDAY

On this Feast of the Most Holy Trinity the Catholic Church proclaims that the God who is One is also three - Father, Son and Holy Spirit. So central to the Christian faith is this doctrine of the Holy Trinity that the entire first section of the Catechism of the Catholic Church is dedicated to an exposition of the biblical and patristic roots of the truth. It should be read, re-read, prayed through, and then read again and again.

The Catechism affirms: 'The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the hierarchy of the truths of faith.

The Father sent His Son, Jesus, to save us from the penalty our sins deserved, death -- and to make us new, by His Blood. Through Him, we are now adopted sons and daughters of the Father. The Father and the Son sent the Holy Spirit, the Spirit of adoption, to make it possible for us to live new lives as adopted sons and daughters of God! We can now call God Father. We are a part of the Family. What a wonderful gift.

Right before He ascended, Jesus commissioned all His disciples - and that includes you and Me - to make disciples of every Nation and, through Baptism, to bring them into the Church, the New Israel, the fulfilment of His loving plan of salvation for every Nation and for all men and women. The Church continues to fulfil this commission. We still baptize in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Baptism brings them into the Mystical Body of Jesus Christ, the Church. They become sons and daughters in the Son. They become joint heirs with Jesus Christ.

May the Lord bless you, your families, the Church, and the Nations of the world. May the blessing of Almighty God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit come upon you as you celebrate the great mystery of the Holy Trinity.
