## Feast of Ss Michael, Gabriel and Raphael, Archangels 29th September

The Bible and the Church recognizes seven archangels, although just three are known by name, Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael. The name Michael means "one who is like God." His will is focused, immovable, and entirely driven toward accomplishing goodness; he is the protector of souls and wields his powerful sword against the poisonous and vindictive aspirations of the devil who Jesus calls a "murderer from the beginning" and the "father of lies" (John 8:44).

Gabriel means "God is my strength". He was sent from God to Nazareth, "to a virgin betrothed to a man named Joseph, . . . and the virgin's name was Mary. Raphael means "God is my health". He is one of seven angels "who enter and serve before the Glory of the Lord" (Tobit 12:15). The meaning of Raphael's name reflects the fact that he touched Tobit's eyes in order to heal them of blindness.

God has commended to each of us an angel for our very own. What love has God for his children, for those he has created in the image of his incarnate Son!
